

ExpoCiencias 2024 Tabasco will be held on the ship 3 of Tabasco Dora María Park, property designed for national and international fairs and exhibitions; Today it is one of the largest and most modern venues in the Mexican Republic. It has 56 hectares of land, 3 air-conditioned warehouses for exhibitions, an open-air theater with capacity for 9,500 seats ideal for shows, a rooster arena, a livestock stand, an artificial lake and ample parking. The event will be located in ship 3 of this venue, with a space of 6,446 m² equipped with high-power lamps, outdoor bathrooms, air conditioning, loading and unloading areas and all the necessary services so that your project is displayed in the best possible conditions and make the event a success.

Located in the Southeast of Mexico, Tabasco has many exciting places, which include the coast, archaeological sites, and natural landscapes, perfect for enjoying your vacation in this paradisiacal state. Project **set up**

By regulation, the installation of the projects must be carried out only on December 3 at the registration times and the projects must be installed in their stands completely at **18:30 p.m.**

All projects will have a **110-volt** two-contact socket and as a recommendation we can suggest you bring some reinforced extension, but not a multi-contact. In case of omitting this recommendation, the staff of the «Ship 3, Dora María Park, Villahermosa» will apply an economic sanction.

In Mexico the connection type is 127V/60Hz; so, we ask you to bring your adapters for the connectors of your appliances, the plugs and sockets must be type A or type B.

Important: The Organizing Committee will not provide any type of material to carry out the presentation of the project (computers, projectors, electrical extensions, etc.) Do not forget to bring with you all the necessary materials for the installation and presentation of the project; this is the responsibility of each participant.

Participants must respect the spaces assigned to each project and **may not change their place** due to the distribution through labels that has been made for the Evaluation Committee.

In addition, for no reason, they **may take furniture or attachments from** the adjoining stands, if they do so the organizing committee will determine the sanction for said action. Participants can stick their posters, tarpaulins or cardboard on the stand, as long as they do not damage the integrity of the stand, since if it turns out to be damaged or mistreated, they will be assigned an economic penalty. It is recommended to use Pritt tak, magnets (in case the poster is light) or butterfly clips (in case it is heavy canvases), it is **forbidden to use adhesive tapes or glues of industrial type** (cinnamon tape, metallic, diurex, Masking tape).



















In order not to interfere with the presentations and out of respect for the projects and their exhibitions, loud music should not be heard. In case of omitting this indication, the staff of the venue and the Organizing Committee will make a wake-up call, and in case of reoffending, the type of sanction for said action will be evaluated.


For safety, it is very important not to leave the stand alone at any time and not to leave in sight things that can be easily misplaced (laser pointers, laptops, photographic or video cameras, etc.). To have access to the facilities and all events, participants must wear their ExpoSciences badge at all times, as an identification element. (There will be no replenishment).

Presentation of projects

All projects must be ready and their speakers must be present at the exhibition hours on **Wednesday December 4th from 10:30 to 14:00 h and Thursday December 5th from 12:00 to 14:00 h**, since the exhibitions and the evaluation of the projects will begin punctually, which is why at least one participant must remain at the assigned stand, It is worth mentioning that the exhibition will be open to the general public and the evaluation committee.

Project **evaluation**

As mentioned in the call, the competition ages are from 15 to 25 years, all those projects whose participants do not meet this age criterion may participate only as a demonstrative.

The evaluation shall consist on a face-to-face assessment.

On the face to face assessment the members of the Evaluation Committee will physically visit the stands where the participants will present their projects.

ExpoCiencias will also be open to the general public during those hours. The Evaluation Committee is composed of professionals in the area in which the project is registered. Projects will be qualified under the following criteria:

Each project will be evaluated by professionals and the arithmetic mean of these evaluations will be the final grade. In the event that any of the evaluators cited and assigned for a certain schedule does not show up, a tenured evaluator will be appointed who will have all the authority to issue the final grade of the project.

Cultural **event**

The deadline to fill out the form is November 20th, 2024, after this date it will be impossible to add anything to the program.

Exchange houses

In Mexico the official currency is the Mexican Peso (MXN) whose current value corresponds to 20.00 MXN = 1 USD approximately, the denomination consist of coins of 50 centavos, 1, 2, 5 and 10 pesos, while in Banknotes the denomination is: 20, 50, 100, 200, 500 and 1000.

We recommend you to change each of your currencies to Mexican Pesos within the same airports in your countries or failing to US Dollars (USD) and later in Mexico to be able to make the change to MXN, since other types of currencies are more complicated to change in Tabasco.

Below we list several Exchange Houses near the Tabasco Dora María park, ordered from the closet to the farthest one, where you can make the change from Dollars to Mexican Pesos.

Extra activities

Tour city

Tabasco, located in the southeast of Mexico, is a state characterized by its exuberant biodiversity, mighty rivers and a warm and humid tropical climate. Known as «land of the Olmecs», it has a rich cultural heritage in its gastronomy, featuring dishes like pejelagarto and chocolate. The capital, Villahermosa, is home to important archaeological sites and museums celebrating its pre-Hispanic history.



La Venta Museum Park in Villahermosa, Tabasco, is a place that houses Olmec sculptures and a variety of local fauna. Walking among the sculptures is a great way to learn about the history of the region.



The Plaza de Armas in Villahermosa, Tabasco, is the heart of the city's historic center and an important meeting point for locals and visitors. You can admire the architecture of iconic buildings, enjoy green spaces, and experience festivals and cultural events. There are several restaurants nearby where you can sample the delicious cuisine of Tabasco. It's an ideal place for taking photographs.



The Papagayo Interactive Museum, located in Villahermosa, Tabasco, is a space designed for education and fun, especially aimed at children and families.



The Tomás Garrido Canabal Park, located in Villahermosa, Tabasco, is a beautiful green space that provides a breath of fresh air from urban life and is ideal for relaxation and outdoor activities, as well as recreational activities, natural areas, cultural events, and boat rides.



The Yumká Park, located in Tabasco, is an eco park and zoo that offers visitors a unique experience of contact with nature and wildlife. It houses a wide variety of native flora and fauna from the region. The park features trails that allow exploration on foot or in safari vehicles. It also has recreational areas and interactive activities.





CICOM zone

The Olmec and Mayan Culture Research Center is a cultural complex with more than 30 years of having been built, this center brings together the most important items of two of the most valuable cultures in Mexico: the Olmec and Mayan cultures.

This center has various facilities such as a library, gallery, educational center, research center, art room and theater that will allow the user to participate in cultural, educational and research activities.

In 2018 this cultural complex was complemented with a cultural corridor where you can find new areas such as a craft trading area, a literacy plaza, a park of the senses, a labyrinth, an auditorium, a path and a viewpoint.

La Venta

This museum houses one of the largest collections of monumental pieces belonging to the Olmec culture, the first civilization of Mesoamerica. This site was designed, organized and created by the Tabasco poet Carlos Pellicer Cámara, and inaugurated on March 4, 1958. It has a space of 6.5 hectares divided into two areas, the archaeological and the zoological.

During the tour, visitors will be able to appreciate animal species native to this tropical area, as well as pre-Hispanic monuments such as the world-famous «colossal heads». During the visit, users will also be able to participate in activities such as children's workshops, exhibitions, conferences, talks, and visit the library.
